Space for the family

The owners of this semi-detached house in west London wanted more space for their teenage children, so they approached **William Tozer Architecture & Design (wtad.co.uk)** to find a solution. By converting the loft they have gained two extra bedrooms, a living room/storage space and shower room. Rather than concealing the shape of the space by boxing in the rooms, the eaves have been taken right down to floor level. Clad in birch ply, the underside of the roof is now a folded, abstract surface (left) that adds interest to the new rooms. One of the bedrooms also benefits from a sliding and folding picture window (below) offering fantastic views over the garden.
